



South Carolina Law Protects The Confidentiality of Library Users' Records*

The records of library materials you borrow or use cannot be disclosed to anyone except:

1. Persons acting within the scope of their duties in the administration of the library or library system;
2. Persons authorized, in writing, by the library patron to inspect their personal records;
3. In accordance with proper judicial order; or
4. In compliance with the USA PATRIOT (Uniting and Strengthening America by Providing Appropriate Tools Required to Intercept and Obstruct Terrorism) Act of 2001 (PL 107-56) regarding terrorist activities.

*Title 60, Chapter 4, of the 1976 Code of Laws applies to any library supported in whole or in part by public funds.
